A. What are the Hong Kong Student Sports Awards?

A.S. Watson Group has always been a keen supporter and sponsor of local sports development and the community at large. We believe that sport is an excellent platform through which Hong Kong citizens can develop a more active lifestyle, and schools is one of the best starting points. In parallel, with an ever-increasing number of talented student athletes emerging, these young people should be recognised and encouraged to pursue their interests and to develop potential.

The “A.S. Watson Group Hong Kong Student Sports Awards” (HKSSA), organised since 2005 with **14,500** students already being honoured in the past 17 years, aims to provide recognition and encouragement annually through school’s nominations. Each school is encouraged to nominate **ONE** student exhibiting outstanding performance or great potential. He or she must also demonstrate passion and good conduct in sport.

B. Objectives

- To recognise students who have demonstrated talent, potential and good conduct in sport
- To recognise the initial achievements of students in sport and, by doing so, provide them positive reinforcement
- To encourage young people to take part in worthwhile physical activities for developing a positive, active and healthy lifestyle; and
- To promote school sporting culture, and build a healthy and young generation for the community

D. Nomination criteria

Student nominees should fulfil the following criteria:

- currently studying in a primary, secondary or special school with full curriculum in the Hong Kong SAR
- having an exceptional performance in sports, also contributing to promotion of sports development in schools (#)
- demonstrating good conduct and sportsmanship
- recommended by his/her school principal

(#) With the cancelation of interschool competitions under COVID-19, it’s recommended to consider nomination of awardees by taking reference to past sports competition performance at discretion.

The organiser of the SSA reserves all rights to accept or decline any nominations and/or disqualify a successful nomination. Final results will be endorsed by the Awards’ Advisory Committee.

E. Awards Programme

Each awardee will receive:

- Arrange professional photographers to take "YOU ARE STAR" modeling photos for all awardees, they can share the photos on social media, more people can recognize and support them in chasing their dream
- An invitation to the Awards Presentation Ceremony, an official scholarship certificate and a scholarship award of HK\$500 will be presented during the ceremony
